Job Overview

The Recovery Alliance Duluth (RAD) Certified Peer Recovery Specialist (CPRS) provides peer-based support to individuals seeking or maintaining recovery from substance use. This role serves individuals across community settings, including those experiencing justice involvement, housing instability, or other barriers to recovery.

The CPRS offers recovery coaching, resource navigation, and peer support to engage participants in building recovery capital and achieving self-defined goals.

This role supports individuals impacted by the criminal justice system in initiating and sustaining recovery, both during incarceration and reentry.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Provide peer support to individuals who are incarcerated
- Participate in DOC transition fairs
- Assist with recovery planning
- Participate in ongoing training and professional development to enhance skills and knowledge relevant to the role
- Support reentry connections
- Maintain documentation

Minimum Qualifications

- CPRS certification prior to hiring
- GED or equivalent
- 2 years continuous recovery
- Valid driver's license



- Have lived experience with the criminal justice system
